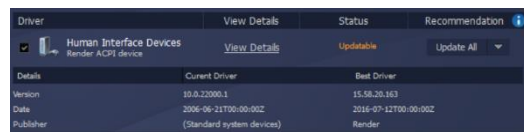

Driver interaction from executed malware was also correctly identified, with a resulting block rate that significantly lowered the associated threat level.
